

Ciudad de Mar completes actions to improve security, accessibility and knowledge of El Confital space

The Council of Ciudad de Mar of the City Council of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria has convened the inter-institutional working table to address the security situation in the accesses and transit areas, accessibility and permitted uses in this natural enclave.

The councilor of the area, José Eduardo Ramírez, presided over a meeting in which technicians of Coasts, Environment of the Government of the Canary Islands, Heritage and Environment of the Cabildo de Gran Canaria and the University Institute of Tourism and Sustainable Economic Development of the University of The Gran Canarian palms. This technical committee will meet again in the coming weeks to propose the measures to be implemented in the short and medium term, some of them before the summer season.

"Our priority is to be able to open the beach to the bathroom as soon as possible. We are waiting for the Public Health of the Government of the Canary Islands to confirm that the good results on water quality in recent months continue and allow us to lower the red flag," said the mayor. In this line the councilor explained that, "in parallel we have continued to work intensively with citizens and other institutions with competence to propose a diagnosis of recreational, educational, social and environmental use that this natural enclave should have."

Among the measures that have already been launched is the development of a technical study "that will show us with empirical data the geological reality of the slopes and the corrective measures that can be adopted to guarantee the safety of the users. The study will be ready in the coming weeks," explained Ramírez, "to present it and start adopting the actions that we all agree on".

Other measures that Ciudad de Mar is studying with technicians is the use of space as a large open air natural classroom, the dissemination and information of cultural, natural and heritage values of this space that allows recognizing collective memory.
