

Ciudad de Mar improves security in La Laja swimming pools with the installation of non-slip pavement

The Ciudad de Mar Department of the City Council of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria has improved, coinciding with the Holy Week bridge, the security in the natural pools of La Laja beach with the installation of 124 square meters of anti-slip flooring.

The work, subsidized with 100% of its cost - 21,057.03 euros - by the Ministry of Presidency and Finance of the Cabildo de Gran Canaria, has involved the assembly of 70.27 square meters in the area of access steps to the central pool, the largest, and 53.15 square meters on the ramps next to the sea. The material used was non-slip pavement type tramex grid polyester reinforced with fiberglass.

The councilman of Ciudad de Mar, José Eduardo Ramírez, and the councilor of the Island Presidency, Pedro Justo, have agreed that inter-institutional collaboration has guaranteed safe access to the sea and enjoyment in this beach leisure equipment in the Southern Cone of the capital of Gran Canaria.

Ramírez recalled that this is one of the actions that the council will carry out throughout 2018 to improve the ride, services and equipment of the La Laja beach. In this sense, in the coming months the installation of a wooden solarium is planned in the surroundings of the swimming pools and the connection of urban services such as water, electricity and telecommunications.
