

Ciudad de Mar monitors the possible arrival of microalgae to the coast of the capital

From the Department of Ciudad de Mar we continue with the tasks of monitoring the possible arrival of microalgae to the bay of the capital. So far, there has been no presence of these cyanobacteria in the coast. Nevertheless, all the services remain vigilant and the city council will apply the recommendations of the Government of the Canary Islands.

As it was decreed yesterday from the regional public health agency, the flowering of cyanobacteria of the species *Trichodesmium erythraeum* is a natural phenomenon derived from the ocean heating, the absence of wind and the presence of calima, which already occurred in 2004 and 2011, and its effects on health are minimal.
