

Ciudad de Mar reorders and improves the hammock service at Las Canteras beach

The City Council of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria has initiated the reordering and improvement in the service of sunbeds and umbrellas in the Playa de Las Canteras with the aim of achieving a better use of the area occupied by each sector and expanding the space for bathers and to leisure citizen.

The main modification will affect the hammock sectors that are located in Playa Grande. In this area, where sector 6 will be permanently inactive and the hammock area next to the Reina Isabel hotel will be unified, leaving sector 10 free, 800 square meters of free sand will be gained from these typical beach loungers.

On the one hand, the booth of sector 6, located at the height of Gomera street that has been without bidder for 5 years, will be removed from the beach and this space will remain as a recreational area. On the other hand, sector 8, at the height of Padre Cueto street, which also became unincorporated since June 2017, will be occupied from now on by hammocks in sector 9.

"Thanks to this action, the users of this beach furniture will be more comfortable and the rest of bathers and citizens will have more sand-free space in the area," said the City of Mar councilor, José Eduardo Ramírez. "It is about continuing to advance in the improvement of quality and sustainability in the main natural space of leisure and meeting citizen of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria," said the mayor.

Repair of the booths

But the relocation of the hammock sectors on the beach is not the only intervention that the Consistory is carrying out in the hammocks and umbrellas service for the beginning of the summer season. Ciudad de Mar has started the works of renovation, repair of deteriorated areas and exterior painting of the 9 storage booths of this beach furniture.

The works consist of deep cleaning, sanding the exterior surface and the roof, cleaning the damaged areas and anticorrosive paint with high resistance to ultraviolet rays. These huts, with dimensions of 11 x 3.27 x 2.90, with a hipped roof, are intended for the storage of the material of the hammocks.

Once the renovation works of the booths are finished, each one will be labeled with its new numbering.

- Sector 2 - C / Tenerife
- Sector 3 - C / Gran Canaria
- Sector 4 - C / La Palma
- Sector 5 - C / Fuerteventura
- Sector 6 - Salvador Cuyás Street (current sector 7)
- Sector 7 - C / Padre Cueto (current sector 8)
- Sector 8 - height of the hotel Reina Isabel (current sector 10)
- Sector 9- C / Tomás Miller (current sector 11)
- Sector 10 - C / Olof Palme
