


# Fifteen professional teams photograph the nocturnal fauna of Las Canteras beach

The Fotosub Nocturno opened last Thursday, September 21, at the Las Canteras beach, the professional competition of the submarine photography contest Fotosub Las Palmas de Gran Canaria 2017. A total of 15 teams participated in this test that will continue today with the school Fotosub and the participation of about one hundred children from four Primary Education Centers in the capital.

Fotosub Nocturno, the first professional event of the event, has become a real demand for the opportunity to capture the nightlife of the seabed of Las Canteras beach that are very difficult to locate during the day. Invertebrates of nocturnal habits such as night shrimp, shrimp, Fabian (a kind of octopus), Carmelites, sand congeries and even fish like the ones that sleep among the rocks became models for one night.

Las Fotos de Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, organized by the councils of Ciudad de Mar and Tourism of the City Council of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria with the sponsorship of the Gran Canaria Tourist Board and the University of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, will again concentrate until next Sunday, 24, to half a thousand participants, most children and amateurs, to photograph Las Canteras with all its appeal, as the great natural aquarium of the city.

The professional photographers who participated in the first competitive test were Goar García, Arturo Telle, Victor Peña, Marcos González, Fernando Robledano, Francisco Van Baumberghen, Daniel Ramírez, Tanausú Motas, Alfredo Ubierna, Maite Asensio, Bruno Hernández, Eladio Frías, José Antonio Rodríguez, Pablo Veiga and Alberto Navarro.

On the other hand, a hundred schoolchildren will participate this Friday morning, from 9 am to 12.30 pm in the School Fotosub, a day that will allow many boys and girls to submerge and meet for the first time the different species to confirm in natural aquarium from Las Canteras beach. The participating schools are CEIP Fernando Guanarteme, CEIP Los Taharales, CEIP Asturias and CEIP Aguadulce.

The professional Fotosub competition will resume on Saturday, September 23, with Cazafotoub, in which 8 teams have been registered, and Open Fotosub, with 11 teams that have confirmed their participation. The competition will begin, in the area of Playa Chica, in Las Canteras, at 8.30 am, under low tide conditions.

The Fotosub LPGC 2017 will deliver its professional awards in a party with live music from 21.30 hours, in the Plaza del Pilar, in the neighborhood of Guanarteme.

On Sunday, 23, it will be the turn of the children's Photosub, where there will be the participation of 200 children, and Fotosub Popular, with a hundred fans. In addition, from 9.00 hours will be carried out a fund clearance of the beach with the aim of sensitizing the population of the need to keep the sea clean.
