

The City Council approves the agreements with the Cabildo to build two lookouts in La Isleta and Las Coloradas

The Plenary Session of the City Council of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria has approved in its session today the signing of two agreements with the Cabildo de Gran Canaria that will allow the construction of two viewpoints in the city located in La Isleta and Las Coloradas. The Mirador de La Isleta will involve an investment of more than 67,000 euros and that of Las Coloradas close to 50,000 euros and will be included in the structuring actions of the Special Territorial Landscape Plan of Gran Canaria.

The councilor for Mobility, Economic Promotion and Ciudad de Mar, José Eduardo Ramírez, has presented to the Corporation the two resolution proposals to formalize these collaboration agreements between the two administrations to allow the execution and conservation of these viewpoints. The City Council has already favorably informed the project of Mirador de La Isleta and the Mirador de Las Coloradas drafted by the Cabildo de Gran Canaria, as well as authorizing the Island Corporation to carry out these works that will be carried out within the Protected Natural Area of La Isleta, for which the approval of the different municipal departments was also obtained, considering that the planned action is compatible with the provisions of the regulations of said natural space.

With these agreements, the Municipal Corporation is committed to provide the Cabildo de Gran Canaria with the execution of the works and to take care of their cleaning, maintenance and conservation once they have been received. A work commission will be responsible for monitoring and maintaining coordination between both administrations to ensure the correct development of these infrastructures.
