

The City Council begins the demolition of the old paseo de la Cícer to end the gap and gain 2,500 meters of beach

The Planning area of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria has begun work on the demolition of the old stretch of the Las Canteras promenade, next to the new La Cícer footbridge, which will last at least two months. This was ensured today by the councilor of Urbanism, Javier Doreste, who has attended the beginning of the demolition work of the old mamotreto.

The process of collapse, which began last May 17, with the removal of the railings, as well as the pavement and lighting of the old promenade to be reused on the new footbridge, has continued today with the partial demolition. This collapse is carried out by several backhoe loaders with hydraulic jaws, which have begun to break and separate the concrete and remove the waste from the structure of the old walk, 110 meters long, which is higher than the rest of the beach avenue at Have been erected on an old parking building. The process of demolition, which will not affect the transit of pedestrians, since several weeks have passed through the new footbridge, will continue during the next two months.

The demolition work involves the closure of the Red Cross facilities and the spa located under the walkway to be demolished, temporary facilities that are totally inoperative. The area of Ciudad de Mar will transfer the Red Cross and spa facilities to the Las Canteras promenade along Calle Calletana Manrique to ensure continuity of service. These works oblige to close the access to the beach by the ramp in which the spa is installed, since the demolitions of the ramp's walls will begin to be able to access the containers and proceed with their removal, probably with a crane.

The Councilor for Urban Development, Javier Doreste, said that "today we are witnessing the creation of the new Cícer footbridge, at a moment with a heavy load of symbolism, I am referring to the fact of throwing the terrible mamotreto that is Raised in the past and that so many problems has generated in the neighbors of the city, to give way to a part of the coast entirely new, much more friendly with 3,000 meters more beach. "

"Considering the good pace with which work progresses, we believe we could complete one of the most important works being carried out in the city before the end of the year," said Doreste.

This second phase of the project includes, besides the demolition of the old promenade between Pizarro and California streets, the construction of a public square, the installation of two escalators, a staircase and two adapted ramps that will join the walk with the beach and the Burial of the power plant located at one end of the promenade.

A total of 29 companies presented themselves to the bidding process commissioned by the Town Planning area of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria to the Municipal Society of Urban Management (GEURSA), which was awarded to the company Satocan, to carry out the Construction of the footbridge of La Cícer. The project to reorganize the Las Canteras promenade in La Cícer, which occupies a total area of 9,821 square meters, represents an investment of 3,606,707 euros.
