


The Fotosub Las Palmas de Gran Canaria will dedicate its 2017 edition to the memory of the photographer and diver Fernando Ros

The Las Palmas de Gran Canaria Under water Photo contest, which will be held at Las Canteras Beach, from September 21 to 24, will recall the trajectory and the divulging work developed by the diver and underwater photographer, Fernando Ros, recently deceased. Ros, known as Nandu in the world of diving, recently passed away. He was linked to the Gran Canaria Open from the outset, first as a participant and later as a juror and co-technical director.

Fernando Ros, based in Gran Canaria for 26 years, dedicated much of his life to the dissemination of diving and the natural treasures of underwater habitats. He was one of the founders of Forobuceo.com the largest site of discussion, consultation and encounter of online diving in Spanish speaking the world.

He was always involved in the development of underwater activities in Gran Canaria, being the director of the Triton Club, one of the first clubs on the island, and he was directly linked to the Insular Federation of Underwater Activities. His support to Fotosub Las Palmas de Gran Canaria started from the first edition as a participant to later become a member of the organization, jury and technical deputy director next to Enrique Faber, director of all professional tests.

Great connoisseur and defender of the main underwater habitats of the world participated in different expeditions and courses of photography. One of his photographs was awarded in the first online contest of underwater photography of the Canary Islands, "The Canary Islands Dive Photo Challenge", organized by Turismo de las Islas Canarias.

The councilor of Ciudad de Mar, José Eduardo Ramírez, explained that it is a matter of remembering and paying tribute to Nandu "a person very dear and valued by all the great family of the world of diving and especially by all those who are linked to Fotosub The Gran Canarian palms. We all very much regret your loss and we would like the divers of the island and all the people linked to the conservation of our coast and our beach to join in a simple act but we hope to be very emotional during the awards ceremony of the professional category " .

Fotosub Las Palmas de Gran Canaria has been meaningful over the last decade as a great event for the local public, with more than a thousand people participating in the different activities, and a growing attraction for visitors in Las

Palmas of Gran Canaria. These data confirm the great interest that underwater photography has in Las Canteras. The professional competition will again have the Fotosub Nocturno, the Open Fotosub and the Cazafotosub.
