

The beaches of Cono Sur are open

The beaches from San Cristóbal to Gando have been opened to the bath in the afternoon of this Sunday for its enjoyment after being verified that the diesel stain has been reduced to less than 20 percent of the spill that occurred after the collision of the ship of Arms in The Port and also stays away from the coast.

The decision has been taken by the Cabildo Island Emergency Plan Directorate after the last coordination meetings with the other administrations and bodies and following the latest reports and inspections carried out from the air and from the ground, stating that diesel has not Arrived at the coast and is not expected to do so, although prudence is maintained.

The decision to keep them closed from San Cristóbal to Gando was a preventive measure to avoid that the threads of the fuel that form in its dispersion affected to the bathers, especially to the smaller ones, but since the situation has improved remarkably, they are open For your enjoyment during the afternoon.

The operation is still active, the aerial inspections of the GES and the beats of Salvamento Marítimo, as well as the actions of municipalities of the capital of Gran Canaria and Telde of its beaches. Finally, the day has passed without incident, so the institutions also thank citizens for their collaboration.
