

The fleet of the ARC regatta completes its 32th departure from Las Palmas de Gran Canaria to the Caribbean

The nautical show at the start of the Atlantic Rally for Cruisers regatta, ARC, returns to Las Palmas de Gran Canaria. The crews of more than 200 sailboats from 35 countries registered, which are docked at the sports dock, will set sail next Sunday, November 19, from 12.00, from the southern coast of the Gran Canaria capital.

The postcard of the ships with the sails deployed saying goodbye to another year of the capital of Gran Canaria will once again attract the attention of thousands of locals and tourists, who will not want to miss this unique show.

Meanwhile, the ARC continues the attention of international media. In fact, the Tourism Board of Gran Canaria has invited journalists from the main European headwaters specialized in nautical sports and numerous media outlets are interested in the event. Among them, the news portal Caribbean News, aimed at tourism professionals, which highlights in a large article published last Sunday, November 12, the celebration of the Atlantic Rally for Cruisers in Las Palmas de Gran Canaria.

Under the headline The regatta ARC'2017 raises flags a week to sail to the Caribbean, this medium describes the parade and raised flag of the event and remembers how the city of Las Palmas de Gran Canaria has been designated in 2017 as Atlantic City, a recognition granted by the European Commission on the Atlantic Arc for being, among other issues, the site of multiple nautical events such as Rendez-Vous Tall Ships and Discoveries Race Los Alisios or Mini-Transat ".

In this article, in the Spanish edition of this portal, also refers to "the 197 boats and more than a thousand sailors will say goodbye to the island on November 19, on a transoceanic journey that will join the participants of ARC Plus ", which departed on November 5 from the capital of Gran Canaria.
